AN ACT to Amend Section Seventy-seven of Chapter Two Hundred and Eleven of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Twenty-one, Relating to Reserved Automobile Registration Numbers.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section seventy-seven of chapter two hundred and eleven  
2 of the public laws of nineteen hundred and twenty-one, is  
3 hereby amended by striking out the word "three" in the  
4 eighth line, and inserting in place thereof the word 'ten,'  
5 so that said section seventy-seven, as amended, shall read  
6 as follows:

'Sect. 77. Whenever the owner has once registered a mo-  
2 tor vehicle, under the provisions of this act, the secretary

3 shall, at the request of such owner, allow him to keep and  
4 use the same number plates for the entire calendar year  
5 for which the plates were issued, provided he complies with  
6 the other provisions of the motor vehicle law. The secre-  
7 tary shall reserve until December first of each year the  
8 same registration number for the succeeding year for per-  
9 sons having registration numbers two to ten thousand for  
10 pleasure vehicles, and numbers one to five hundred for com-  
11 mercial vehicles, if such person shall, previous to the first  
12 day of December of the current year, pay for the registra-  
13 tion of his vehicle for the succeeding year and otherwise  
14 comply with the provisions of the motor vehicle law.'
