STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Authorizing the Transfer of the Real Estate Used
as a Ferry Landing at Bath, Maine, from the State of Maine
to the City of Bath.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The governor and council are hereby authorized and in-
2 structed in behalf of the State of Maine to convey and
3 transfer by quit-claim deed to the City of Bath, the real es-
4 tate used as a landing place for the state ferry, and located
5 on the west side of the Kennebec river in said Bath. The
6 transfer is to be made upon completion of the "Kennebec
7 bridge," and as soon as the state ferry is discontinued, upon
8 condition that the city of Bath shall keep said real estate in
9 repair and maintain it as a free public landing.
