IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Providing Compensation for Court Stenographers
Upon Retiring by Reason of Disability.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Stenographers of the supreme judicial and
2 superior courts upon arriving at the age of seventy years
3 and having served twenty-five years in either or both courts
4 may, by reason of disability and with the approval of the
5 judge under whom they are serving at the time, retire, and
6 shall receive from the state twelve hundred dollars per an-
7 num to be paid by the treasurer of state in monthly pay-
8 ments.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect the first day of January,
2 A. D., one thousand nine hundred and twenty-eight.
