STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to the Jurisdiction of the Probate Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

In all cases where the appointment of a guardian has been,
2 or is, made by a judge of probate in any adjoining county,
3 or the administration of a ward's estate has been, or is,
4 transferred to any adjoining county by reason that the judge
5 of probate of the county where the ward or wards reside
6 is interested either in his own right, in trust, or in any other
7 manner, or is within the sixth degree of kindred, that when-
8 ever the disability of the judge of probate is removed before
9 the proceedings have been fully completed the proceedings
10 shall then be transferred to the probate court which other-

11 wise would have had jurisdiction or to the probate court
12 of original jurisdiction for the completion of the adminis-
13 tration of such estate, and in all such cases the register
14 in such adjoining county shall transmit copies of all records
15 relating to such estate to the probate office of the county
16 where such estate belongs to be there recorded.
