IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relative to Enforcement of Motor Vehicle Laws.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

In addition to other means of enforcement of the highway
2 and motor vehicle law or regulation relating thereto as now
3 provided by statute, and the collection of the tax on gaso-
4 line, the state highway commission may, whenever in their
5 judgment existing conditions demand or the public interest
6 requires, assign for either of said purposes any men in the
7 employ of the highway department to act in conjunction
8 with any other state, county or town officers; provided, how-
9 ever, that no person in the employ of the highway depart-

10 ment should be assigned for any duties relating to the
11 enforcement of any law unless the business of the highway
12 department permits it or that otherwise the person assigned
13 would be unemployed.
