## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

---

AN ACT Relating to the Protection of Moose.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Paragraph one of section thirty-seven of chapter two  
2 hundred nineteen of the public laws of nineteen hundred  
3 seventeen, as amended by chapter one hundred and thirty-  
4 one of the public laws of nineteen hundred and nineteen,  
5 as amended by chapter one hundred and five of the public  
6 laws of nineteen hundred twenty-one and by chapter eighty-  
7 three of the public laws of nineteen hundred twenty-five,  
8 is hereby further amended by inserting at the beginning  
9 of said section the following: 'Whoever, in the county of  
10 Waldo, from the first day of December in each year to the  
11 fifteenth day of November of the following year and,' and

12 by adding at the end of the first line thereof the words  
13 'elsewhere in the state,' so that said paragraph as amended  
14 shall read as follows:

'Sect. 37. Par. 1. Whoever, in the county of Waldo,  
2 from the first day of December in each year to the fifteenth  
3 day of November of the following year and whoever, else-  
4 where in the state, at any time, for a period of four years  
5 from July seventh, nineteen hundred and twenty-five, hunts,  
6 pursues, or kills any moose, or has in his possession any  
7 part or parts thereof, whenever or wherever taken, caught  
8 or killed, shall pay a fine of not less than two hundred  
9 dollars, nor more than three hundred dollars and costs for  
10 each offense, or be imprisoned not exceeding four months,  
11 or shall be subject to both said fine and imprisonment.'
