SENATE AMENDMENT A TO HOUSE DOCUMENT
NO. 44

Strike out the word "seven" in lines six and thirteen. In
2 place thereof insert the word 'six,' so that lines one to six-
3 teen inclusive shall read:

Chapter six of the revised statutes as amended by chapter
2 sixty-two of nineteen hundred twenty-five is hereby further
3 amended by striking out lines twenty and twenty-one thereof
4 and inserting in place thereof the following: "The polls will
5 be opened at o'clock in the forenoon and con-
6 tinue open until six o'clock in the afternoon, when they
7 will close,' and by striking out in the thirty-seventh and
8 thirty-eighth lines thereof the words "The meetings shall be

9 opened and closed as stated in the form of the warrant fore-
10 going,” and inserting in place thereof the following: “The
11 meetings may be opened at six o’clock in the forenoon and
12 shall be opened not later than ten o’clock in the forenoon.
13 The polls shall be kept open until six o’clock in the after-
14 noon and shall then be closed. Notice of the time of opening
15 and closing shall be given in the warrant calling the meet-
16 ing,’ so that said chapter, as amended, shall read as follows:
