STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Amend Section Ninety-two of Chapter Two Hundred Eleven of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred Twenty-one, Relative to Disposition of Motor Vehicle Fees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section ninety-two of chapter two hundred eleven of the 2 public laws of nineteen hundred twenty-one is hereby

- 3 amended by inserting after the word "state" in the eighth
- 4 line of said section, the words 'and state,' so that said sec-
- 5 tion as amended shall read as follows.

'Sect. 92. Disposition of motor vehicle fees. All fees and

- 2 moneys received by the secretary under the preceding sec-
- 3 tions shall be turned over to the treasurer of state as pro-
- 4 vided in section twenty-six of this act and shall be appro-

5 priated and used for the administration of the office and 6 duties of the commission as provided by general law, in-7 cluding the expenses of administering the motor vehicle de-8 partment and the licensing of operators and registration of 9 vehicles, and for the repair and maintenance of state and 10 state aid highways under the direction of the commission 11 and to meet all provisions of the bond issues for highway 12 construction as heretofore provided by statute.
