STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Taking Alewives in Eastern Penobscot
River in the Town of Orland.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section three of chapter three hundred sixty-seven of the
2 private and special laws of nineteen hundred three is hereby
3 amended by striking out all of said section, and substitut-
4 ing in place thereof the following section:

'Sect. 3. Any of the alewives in said river above a point
2 five hundred yards below the lower dam may be taken by
3 the town of Orland on Mondays, Tuesdays and Wednes-
4 days of each week from the first day of May to the fif-

5 teenth day of July, if the town so votes at its annual meet-
6 ing. The town may vote at any annual meeting to so take
7 said fish for a period of not exceeding five years in suc-
8 cession.'
