STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Pownal State School for Additions
and Improvements.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated for
2 the Pownal State School for new construction and improve-
3 ments for the period from July first, nineteen hundred and
4 twenty-seven to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twen-
5 ty-eight the sum of eighty thousand dollars, to be spent by
6 the trustees of the institution under the direction of the
7 governor and council.

Provided further, that the sum herein appropriated shall
2 be expended as follows:

	1927-1928
Build one administration building,	\$80,000 00

Provided that any balance of the sum above appropriated
2 for the year nineteen hundred and twenty-eight which may
3 remain unexpended, shall be available for expenditure dur-
4 ing the period July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-eight,
5 to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine.
