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## STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

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AN ACT Relating to the Employment of Guides by  
Non-residents.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section sixty-three of chapter two hundred nineteen of  
2 the public laws of nineteen hundred seventeen, as amended  
3 by chapter one hundred ninety-six of the public laws of  
4 nineteen hundred nineteen, and by chapter one hundred  
5 nineteen of the public laws of nineteen hundred twenty-  
6 three, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following  
7 sentence: 'The provisions of this section shall not apply to  
8 non-resident fishermen who camp within the limits of pub-  
9 lic camp sites maintained by the Maine Forest Service, or  
10 who build camp fires in the fireplaces provided by the Maine  
11 Forest Service on such camp sites.'
