IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Assent to the Purpose and Provisions of an Act of the Congress of the United States Entitled "An Act to Authorize the More Complete Endowment of Agricultural Experiment Stations, and for Other Purposes."

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The state of Maine hereby assents to the purpose and provisions of an act of the congress of the United States, approved February twenty-fourth, nineteen hundred and four twenty-five, entitled "An Act to authorize the more complete endowment of agricultural experiment stations, and for other purposes," accepts the grants of money authorized by said act, and hereby assigns all such moneys to the Maine Agricultural Experiment Station for its use.
