S T A T E O F M A I N E

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, in Favor of Eliphalet Washburn of Dexter, Me.,
for Pension.

Resolved: That a pension of twenty dollars per month
2 be and hereby is granted to Eliphalet Washburn of Dexter,
3 Maine, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions
4 for soldiers and their dependents. Said pension shall begin
5 July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-seven, and continue
6 until otherwise provided by the legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The within applicant is 81 years of age, and in a state of impaired health. He lives at Dexter, Maine. There is no chance that he will ever be any better. He has no means and it is necessary that some provision be made to help him.
