### STATE OF MAINE

# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Registration in Optometry.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section forty-five of chapter eighteen of the revised stat-

- 2 rutes is hereby amended by adding after the word "state"
- 3 in the first line thereof, the following: 'nor sell spectacles,
- 4 eyeglasses, or lenses for the purpose of correcting defective
- 5 vision,' and by striking out all of said section after the
- 6 word "resident" in the seventh line thereof and inserting in
- 7 place thereof the following: 'registered optometrists and
- 8 dispensing opticians,' so that said section as amended shall
- 9 read as follows:

'Sect. 45. No person shall practice optometry in this state, 2 nor sell spectacles, eyeglasses or lenses for the purpose of 3 correcting defective vision, unless he shall first obtain a 4 certificate of registration from the state board of registra-5 tion and examination in optometry, and file the same with 6 the clerk of the supreme judicial court of the county in 7 which he proposes to practice, as hereinafter provided; but 8 sections forty-three to fifty-five, both inclusive, shall not 9 apply to physicians and surgeons authorized to practice 10 medicine and engage therein under the laws of the state, 11 nor to resident registered optometrists and dispensing op-12 ticians.'
