STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Authorizing Officials in Charge of Penal or Correctional Institutions to Institute a System of Compensation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: The officials in charge of any penal or correctional insti-2 tution are authorized to institute a system of compensation 3 out of any funds coming within their control, provided, 4 however, that this shall not occasion any overdraft in their 5 funds and provided further that such system shall first be 6 approved by and its continuance shall be subject to the ap-7 proval of the governor and council.
