RESOLVE, in Favor of Wallace W. Yates of Grand Lake Stream, Washington County, Maine.

Resolved: That the sum of thirty-five dollars be and is
2 hereby appropriated to be paid Wallace W. Yates of Grand
3 Lake Stream, Washington County, Maine, to reimburse him
4 for damage by deer during the season of nineteen hundred
5 and twenty-six to his crop of beans.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Under the present law, no department of the state is authorized to approve claim for damage by deer to growing crops. In order to reimburse Mr. Yates for the damage suffered, this resolve is introduced.
