STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Western Maine Sanatorium for the Maintenance, Personal Services, Repairs and Equipment.

Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated for
2 the Western Maine Sanatorium for the fiscal year from
3 July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-seven, to June thir-
4 tieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-eight, one hundred and
5 forty thousand dollars, and for the fiscal year from July
6 first, nineteen hundred and twenty-eight, to June thirtieth,
7 nineteen hundred and twenty-nine, the sum of one hun-
8 dred and forty thousand dollars. Of said sums there shall
9 be applied in each fiscal year for maintenance seventy-two
10 thousand five hundred dollars, for personal services forty-
11 nine thousand five hundred dollars, and for repairs and
12 equipment eighteen thousand dollars.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The Western Maine Sanatorium owned by the State of Maine is used for the purpose of treating patients effected by tuberculosis and this resolve is to provide money so that the Sanatorium may be carried on in the same way as it has in the past.
