IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, in Favor of Western Maine Sanatorium for the Construction of an Annex to Reception Room.

Emergency Preamble. Whereas, an annex to the reception room hereinafter mentioned can be constructed to much better advantage to the state if the contracts therefor are let early in the season and the work begun as soon as possible, and

Whereas, money for such construction cannot be used until the funds provided by this resolve become available and loss and inconvenience will result if such work is not started early in the season, and

Whereas, in the judgment of the legislature these facts create an emergency within the meaning of section sixteen of article thirty-one of the constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, now, therefore, be it

Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated for

the Western Maine Sanatorium the sum of ten thousand dol
lars for the construction of an annex to the reception room.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The reception room at the Western Maine Sanatorium is not large enough at the present time to take care of the needs of the Sanatorium and this resolve is for the purpose of providing an annex to the reception room so that it will be sufficient for the institution's needs.
