RESOLVE, in Favor of the Western Maine Sanatorium for a Water Tank.

Emergency Preamble. Whereas, the water tank hereinafter mentioned can be constructed to much better advantage to the state if the contracts therefor are let early in the season and the work begun as soon as possible, and

Whereas, money for such construction cannot be used until the funds provided by this resolve become available and loss and inconvenience will result if such work is not started early in the season, and

Whereas, in the judgment of the legislature these facts create an emergency within the meaning of section sixteen of article thirty-one of the constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, now, therefore, be it

Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated for the

- 2 Western Maine Sanatorium the sum of three thousand five
- 3 hundred dollars for the construction of a water tank.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The Western Maine Sanatorium at the present time has practically no fire protection. This resolve is for the purpose of constructing a water tank and providing fire protection for the property of the state at said institution.
