STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Northern Maine Sanatorium for Maintenance, Personal Services, Repairs and Equipment.

Resolved: That the sum of two hundred seventeen thou-2 sand three hundred and fifty dollars be applied for the 3 Northern Maine Sanatorium, one hundred ten thousand 4 one hundred and twenty-five dollars of said sum to be used 5 during the period commencing July first, nineteen hundred 6 and twenty-seven, and ending June thirtieth, nineteen hun-7 dred and twenty-eight, and divided as follows: Thirty-8 seven thousand dollars for personal services, sixty thou-9 sand dollars for maintenance, and thirteen thousand one 10 hundred and twenty-five dollars for repairs and equipment, 11 and one hundred and seven thousand two hundred and 12 twenty-five dollars of said sum for the period commencing

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13 July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-eight, and ending 14 June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine, divided 15 as follows: Thirty-seven thousand dollars for personal serv-16 ices, sixty thousand dollars for maintenance, and ten thou-17 sand two hundred and twenty-five dollars for equipment 18 and repairs.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The Northern Maine Sanatorium owned by the State of Maine is used for the purpose of treating patients affected by tuberculosis and this resolve is to provide money so that the sanatorium may be carried on in the same way as it has in the past.
