## STATE OF MAINE

# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Northern Maine Sanatorium for the Construction and Equipment of a Men's Cottage.

#### EMERGENCY PREAMBLE

Whereas, the building and equipment hereinafter mentioned can be constructed and equipped to much better advantage to the state if the contracts therefor are let early in the season and the work begun as soon as possible, and

Whereas, money for such construction and equipment cannot be used until the funds provided by this resolve become available and loss and inconvenience will result if such work is not started early in the season, and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature these facts create an emergency within the meaning of section sixteen of article thirty-one of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, now, therefore, be it

*Resolved:* That there be, and hereby is, appropriated for 2 the Northern Maine Sanatorium the sum of seven thousand 3 five hundred dollars for the building and equipping of a 4 men's cottage.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

At the present time there are not suitable quarters for the men at the Northern Maine Sanatorium, and this resolve is for the purpose of providing and equipping a men's cottage which is very much needed.
