IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Central Maine Sanatorium for
Maintenance, Personal Services, Repairs and Equipment.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated for
2 the Central Maine Sanatorium for the fiscal year from July
3 first, nineteen hundred and twenty-seven, to June thirtieth,
4 nineteen hundred and twenty-eight, the sum of one hundred
5 forty-six thousand dollars, of which there shall be applied
6 for maintenance eighty-eight thousand dollars, for personal
7 services forty-four thousand dollars, and for repairs and
8 equipment fourteen thousand dollars, and for the fiscal year
9 July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-eight, to June thir-
10 tieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine, one hundred and
11 forty-six thousand dollars, of which there shall be applied

12 for maintenance eighty-eight thousand dollars, for personal
13 services forty-four thousand dollars, and for repairs and
14 equipment fourteen thousand dollars.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The Central Maine Sanatorium owned by the State of Maine is used for the purpose of treating patients effected by tuberculosis and this resolve is to provide money so that the Sanatorium may be carried on in the same way as it has in the past.
