## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Central Maine Sanatorium for the Construction and Equipment of a Nurse's Home.

#### EMERGENCY PREAMBLE

Whereas the nurse's home hereinafter mentioned can be constructed and equipped to much better advantage to the state if the contracts therefor are let early in the season and the work begun as soon as possible, and whereas money for such construction and equipment cannot be used until the funds provided by this resolve become available, and loss and inconvenience will result if such work is not started early in the season, and whereas in the judgment of the Legislature these facts create an emergency within the meaning of section sixteen of article thirty-one of the Constitution of Maine, and

require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety: now therefore be it

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated for 2 the Central Maine Sanatorium the sum of forty thousand 3 dollars for the construction and equipment of a nurse's 4 home.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

At the present time the nurses at the Central Maine Sanatorium are quartered in the same buildings as are patients. This resolve is for the purpose of providing a separate building for the nurses and equipping the same.
