STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Amend the Law Regarding Advertising Signs in
Public Highways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section two of chapter one hundred eighty-eight of the
2 public laws of nineteen hundred and twenty-five is hereby
3 amended by striking out the last sentence thereof and in-
4 serting in its place the following:

'The state highway police shall remove all signs, billboards,
2 panels, placards, posters, notices or other advertising devices
3 existing within thirty-three feet of the center of the high-
4 way, or travelled roadway in violation hereof.'
