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## STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

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AN ACT Authorizing the Transfer of the Real Estate Used  
as a Ferry Landing at Woolwich, Maine, from the State of  
Maine to the Town of Woolwich.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The governor and council are hereby authorized and in-  
2 structed in behalf of the state of Maine, to convey and  
3 transfer by quit-claim deed to the town of Woolwich, the  
4 real estate used as a landing place for the state ferry, and  
5 located on the east side of the Kennebec River in said town  
6 of Woolwich. The transfer is to be made upon comple-  
7 tion of the "Kennebec Bridge," and as soon as the state

8 ferry is discontinued, upon condition that the town of  
9 Woolwich shall keep said real estate in repair and main-  
10 tain it as a free public landing.
