IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Passamaquoddy Tribe of Indians for the General Care, Maintenance and Education Thereof, at Pleasant Point at Perry, Maine.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from 2 the state treasury to be expended under the direction of 3 the governor and council by the agent of the Passamaquod-4 dy tribe of Indians, for the benefit of said tribe for the 5 year from July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-seven 6 to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-eight, and 7 for the year from July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-8 eight to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine, 9 as follows:
