AN ACT in Favor of Frank J. Durgin, of West Forks
Plantation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

That Frank J. Durgin of West Forks Plantation is hereby 2 made eligible for pension under chapter thirty-eight of the 3 public laws of nineteen hundred nineteen.
