STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Provide for an Approach to the Kennebec Bridge
and to Acquire the Same by Purchase or Eminent Domain.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The directors of the Kennebec bridge as defined and described in chapter eighty-nine of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred twenty-five are hereby authorized and directed to acquire by purchase or by the right of eminent domain, in accordance with the provisions of chapter fifty-six, sections twenty-four to forty-one of the revised statutes, said chapter and sections relating to the taking of lands by railroads being made especially applicable for the purpose of this act, lands in the city of Bath, the same being lands on Vine and Water streets in said city of Bath, as a suitable approach to the Kennebec bridge so-called in the

12 city of Bath, the moneys to be paid for said lands to be
13 disbursed and paid out of the proceeds of the bonds issued
14 by the state of Maine in accordance with section nine of
15 said chapter eighty-nine of the private and special laws of
16 nineteen hundred twenty-five.
