STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Protect Muskrats in the Towns of Bucksport and Orland, in the County of Hancock.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section 1. For a period of two years from July eleventh,
2 nineteen hundred twenty-seven, it shall be unlawful for any
3 person to hunt, trap, kill, pursue or catch any muskrat, or
4 muskrats, in the town of Bucksport, or in the town of Or5 land, in the county of Hancock.

Sect. 2. It shall also be unlawful for any person to have 2 in possession, at any time, any muskrat, or muskrats, or part 3 thereof, taken in violation of any provision of this act.

Sect. 3. Whoever violates any provision of this act shall 2 be subject to a penalty of not less than ten dollars and costs 3 for each offense, and three dollars additional for each musk4 rat or part thereof hunted, killed, trapped, pursued, caught,5 or had in possession, in violation hereof.

Sect. 4. In all prosecutions arising under this act, trial 2 justices, police and municipal courts, within their counties, 3 shall have original and concurrent jurisdiction with the su-4 preme judicial court and superior courts.
