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## STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

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AN ACT to Amend Section Twenty-one of Chapter One Hundred and Seventeen of the Revised Statutes, as Amended by Chapter One Hundred and Forty-four, Public Laws Nineteen Twenty-one, Relating to the Salary of the Commissioner of Agriculture.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section twenty-one of chapter one hundred and seventeen  
2 of the revised statutes is hereby further amended by strik-  
3 ing out the words "three thousand" in the second line of said  
4 section and substituting in place thereof the words 'three  
5 thousand five hundred,' so that said section, as amended,  
6 shall read as follows:

'Sect. 21. The commissioner of agriculture shall receive  
2 an annual salary of three thousand five hundred dollars.

3 He shall also receive his actual expenses incurred in the  
4 performance of his official duties but not exceeding the sum  
5 of one thousand dollars a year. He may expend for such  
6 clerical labor as may be required not exceeding one thou-  
7 sand dollars a year to be approved by the governor and  
8 council.
