RESOLVE, Appropriating Money to Reimburse the Town of  
Orland for Support of George Savoy.

---

*Resolved:* That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the  
2 sum of eighteen hundred and ninety-eight dollars and sev-  
3 enty cents (\$1,898.70), to reimburse the town of Orland  
4 for money expended for the support of George Savoy, a  
5 pauper, who should be supported by the state.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

This old man is a Canadian, never married, never naturalized, never owned any real estate or home, and has never acquired a pauper settlement in Maine.
