STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Provide for the Filling of Vacancies in the Office of Constable in Cities.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

If in any city a vacancy occurs in the office of constable, 2 either through the failure of a duly elected or appointed 3 constable to qualify by filing his bond within thirty days 4 after his election or appointment, or through the death, 5 resignation or removal of a qualified constable, or through 6 the failure of any ward or precinct to elect its allotted num-7 ber of constables, the municipal officers may fill such va-8 cancy by appointing a constable whose term of office shall 9 expire at the same time as it would if he had been elected 11 at the preceeding annual city election.
