# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

House Document three hundred ninety-four is hereby amend-

- 2 ed by striking out all after the word "two" in line three on
- 3 page one and inserting in place thereof the following:
- 4 'weeks in the year nineteen hundred twenty-eight and an-
- 5 nually thereafter,' so that section twenty shall read as
- 6 follows:

'Sect. 20. Equal school privileges shall be provided for

- 2 all pupils. R. S. c. 15, S. 17. 1909, c. 29. 1915, c. 89. The
- 3 school moneys of every town shall be so expended as to
- 4 give as nearly as practicable the same aggregate annual
- 5 length of terms in all its schools, and every town shall make
- 6 provision for the maintenance of all its schools for not less
- 7 than thirty-two weeks in the year nineteen hundred twenty-

8 eight and annually thereafter. Any town failing to maintain 9 its schools as provided in this section, shall be debarred from 10 drawing its state school moneys until it shall have made 11 suitable provisions for so maintaining them thereafter.'
