STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, to Appropriate Money for the Purpose of Operating Fish Hatcheries and Feeding Stations for Fish, for the Protection of Fish, Game and Birds and for Printing the Report of the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game, and for Maintenance of the Maine State Museum and for Other Expenses Incident to the Administration of the Department of Inland Fisheries and Game.

Resolved: That the sum of three hundred and seventy

2 thousand dollars be, and hereby is, appropriated, as follows:

One hundred and eighty-five thousand dollars for the

- 2 period between July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-
- 3 seven, and June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-eight,

4 and one hundred and eighty-five thousand dollars for the 5 period between July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-6 eight, and June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine, 7 to be expended by the commissioner of inland fisheries and 8 game for the purpose of operating the fish hatcheries and 9 feeding stations for fish in the state, for the protection of 10 fish, game and birds, for printing the report of the com-11 missioner of inland fisheries and game, for maintenance of 12 the Maine state museum, payment of bounty on bobcats 13 killed in this state, and all other expenses incident to the 14 administration of the department of inland fisheries and 15 game, and that any of this appropriation unexpended at the 16 end of either year shall be available for the following year, 17 as a continuing account.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This is the usual resolve appropriating funds for the maintenance of the department of inland fisheries and game—for the same amount that was appropriated by the Legislature of 1925.
