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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

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AN ACT to Increase the Salary of the Judge of the Western  
Somerset Municipal Court.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section eight of chapter three hundred thirty-one of the  
2 private and special laws of nineteen hundred and nine is  
3 hereby amended by striking out the words "fourteen hun-  
4 dred" in the third line of said section and inserting in place  
5 thereof the words 'sixteen hundred,' so that said section,  
6 as amended, shall read as follows:

'Sect. 8. As compensation for his services in that capacity  
2 the judge of said court shall receive an annual salary of

3 sixteen hundred dollars, payable in quarterly installments  
4 from the treasury of the county of Somerset, on the first  
5 days of January, April, July and October; and all fees  
6 received by him in said capacity shall be by him turned  
7 over to the county of Somerset. He shall account quarterly  
8 under oath to the county treasurer for all fees received by  
9 him, specifying the items, and shall pay the same to said  
10 treasurer quarterly, on the first days of January, April,  
11 July and October; and he shall annually, and as much  
12 oftener as required by the county commissioners of said  
13 county produce before said commissioners the docketts,  
14 records and accounts of said court, and be inquired of by  
15 them as fully as they deem necessary with reference to all  
16 his official acts. The fees to be demanded and received by  
17 said judge shall remain as heretofore, except that the fee  
18 for each blank writ, signed and sealed, shall be four cents,  
19 including the summons for same.
