STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Ice Fishing in Annabessacook Lake, in Kennebec County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to fish

- 2 for, take, catch or kill, at any time, any kind of fish on or
- 3 through the ice in Annabessacook lake, which lake is situ-
- 4 ated partly in the town of Winthrop and partly in the town
- 5 of Monmouth, in the county of Kennebec.
 - Sect. 2. It shall also be unlawful for any person to have
- 2 in possession at any time any kind of fish taken on or
- 3 through the ice in said lake.
- Sect. 3. Whoever violates any provision of this act shall 2 be subject to a fine of not less than ten dollars nor more

- 3 than thirty dollars and costs for each offense, and one JoI-
- 4 lar additional for each fish taken, caught, killed or had in
- 5 possession in violation of any provision of this act.
 - Sect. 4. In all prosecutions arising under this act, trial
- 2 justices, police and municipal courts within their counties
- 3 shall have, upon complaint, original and concurrent juris-
- 4 diction with the supreme judicial court, and superior courts.
 - Sect. 5. So much of the existing rules and regulations
- 2 of the department of inland fisheries and game, relating to
- 3 ice fishing in said Annabessacook lake, as is inconsistent
- 4 with the provisions of this act is hereby repealed.
