STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Oakland for Money
Paid for Mother's Aid.

Resolved: That there be appropriated the sum of four
2 hundred and eighty dollars to reimburse the town of Oak-
3 land for money paid during the years 1925 and 1926 for
4 mother's aid for the family of Harry Sabine, a state pauper.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

That the said Harry Sabine was emancipated by a decree in a divorce proceedings; that the pauper settlement of the father of said Harry Sabine was unknown and uncertain at the time of said emancipation and that the same has never since been determined; that the said Harry Sabine has never acquired a pauper settlement in his own right; that his children are subjects of the mothers' aid law and that the town of Oakland has paid out the sum of four hundred and eighty dollars during the years 1925 and 1926 in consequence of the provisions of said mothers' aid law.
