STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relative to the Use of Funds of Indian Tribes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter fourteen of the revised statutes is hereby amended
2 by adding the following section:

'Sect. 55. The governor and council may expend for the
2 benefit of either Indian tribe any portion of the funds of
3 that tribe; provided, however, that the expenditure will not
4 decrease the principal of the fund to such an extent as to
5 prevent compliance with any existing provisions of statute,
6 and provided further, that the tribe whose funds are used,
7 shall consent to the expenditure at a meeting duly called for
8 the purpose.'
