**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN**

AN ACT Relating to Continuous Roads Through Three or
More Towns.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter one hundred and fifty-four of the public laws of
2 nineteen hundred and seventeen as amended by chapter one
3 hundred and fifty-seven of the public laws of nineteen hun-
4 dred and nineteen is hereby further amended by adding the
5 following section:

'Any and all towns which are so located with reference to
2 the state boundary or adjoining towns that it is impossible
3 to form an association of towns as contemplated in this act
4 for the building of state aid highways because when such
5 adjoining town or towns have completed construction on

6 state aid highway locations thereby making impractical to
7 form a union of towns as contemplated in this act may of
8 itself apply for and receive the benefits of this act for the
9 building of state aid highway on any location extending
10 across said town.'
