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**S T A T E O F M A I N E**

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**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN**

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RESOLVE, in Favor of Henry A. Day, of Bangor, County of Penobscot and State of Maine, Compensating Him for Loss Sustained in Road Construction upon State Highway.

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Resolved: That the state treasurer be, and he is hereby  
2 authorized and directed to pay to Henry A. Day, of Ban-  
3 gor, county of Penobscot, state of Maine, the sum of sev-  
4 enty-five hundred dollars to be paid out of the state high-  
5 way bond money, said sum being on account of the con-  
6 struction of that part of the state or cement road beginning  
7 at a point at or near the dividing line between the town of  
8 Veazie and the town of Orono, county of Penobscot, and

9 extending in a northerly direction to a point in the town  
10 of Orono, Penobscot county, state of Maine, just beyond  
11 the Basin Mills road, so-called.
