AN ACT to Amend Chapter One Hundred Sixty-three of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred Twenty-five Relating to Transfer from One Sub-division of a Department Appropriation to Another.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section two of chapter one hundred sixty-three of the public laws of nineteen hundred twenty-five is hereby amended by adding after the word "institution" of the last line of said section the words 'for the same fiscal year' so that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 2. Unexpended appropriations may be transferred to other appropriations for same department or institution.
Any balance of any appropriation or sub-division of an ap-

4 appropriation made by the legislature for any state department
5 or state institution, which at any time may not be required
6 for the purposes named in such appropriation or sub-division
7 may, upon recommendation of the state auditor, be trans-
8 ferred by the governor and council to any other appropri-
9 ation or sub-division of an appropriation made by the legis-
10 lature for the use of the same department or the same in-
11 stitution for the same fiscal year.'
