AN ACT to Increase the Salary of the Register of Deeds in
the County of Aroostook, Northern District.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 117, sec. 43; relating to compensation of registers of deeds, amended. Section forty-three of chapter one hundred and seventeen of the revised statutes, is hereby amended by striking out in the sixth line thereof the words, "Aroostook, northern registry, one thousand dollars" and inserting in place thereof the words 'Aroostook, northern registry, thirteen hundred dollars,' so that said section so far as it relates to the salary of the register of deeds, Aroostook county, northern district, shall read as follows:

Aroostook county, northern registry, increased. 'Aroostook, northern registry, thirteen hundred dollars.'
