AN ACT to Increase the Salaries of the Clerks in the Offices of the Clerk of Courts, the Register of Probate and the Register of Deeds for Sagadahoc County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

That that paragraph of section forty-five of chapter one hundred and seventeen of the revised statutes which relates to salaries of clerks in the offices of the clerk of courts the register of probate and the register of deeds for Sagadahoc county, as amended by chapter two hundred and sixty-six of the public laws of nineteen hundred and seventeen, and as further amended by chapter two hundred and eighty-nine of the public laws of nineteen hundred and twenty-one, and as further amended by chapters forty-one, forty-two, forty-six and forty-nine of the public laws of nineteen

11 hundred and twenty-five is hereby further amended by strik-
12 ing out the whole of said paragraph, and substituting the
13 following words therefor, so that the same, as amended,
14 shall read as follows:

‘Sagadahoc county; for clerks in the office of register of
2 deeds, fifteen hundred and sixty dollars; for clerks in the
3 office of register of probate, ten hundred and forty dollars;
4 for clerks in the office of clerk of courts, ten hundred and
5 forty dollars.’
