## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Clerk Hire in the Office of Register of Probate for Knox County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: R. S., c. 117, sec. 45; P. L., 1921, c. 219; 1925, c. 47; 2 relating to clerk hire in county offices, amended. Section 3 forty-five of chapter one hundred and seventeen of the 4 revised statutes, as amended by chapter two hundred and 5 nineteen of the public laws of nineteen hundred and twenty-6 one, as amended by chapter forty-seven of the public laws 7 of nineteen hundred and twenty-five, so much thereof as re-8 lates to the amount allowed for clerk hire in the office of 9 the register of probate of Knox county is hereby further 10 amended by striking out the words "seven hundred and 11 twenty dollars" and inserting in place thereof the words 12 'seven hundred and eighty dollars,' so that said lines of 13 said section relating to clerk hire in the office of the regis-14 ter of Probate of Knox county, as amended, shall read as 15 follows: 'for clerks in the office of register of probate 16 seven hundred and eighty dollars.'

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

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This raise in salary will bring the compensation of the clerk in the office of the Probate Court up on an equality with that of the clerks in the offices of the Clerk of Courts and Register of Deeds in Knox County.

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
