AN ACT to Amend Section Fifteen of Chapter One Hundred Fifty-four of the Private and Special Laws of Nineteen Hundred Eleven, as Amended by Chapter Forty-four of the Private and Special Laws of Nineteen Hundred Fifteen, Relative to an Increase in the Salary of the Judge of the Houlton Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section fifteen of chapter one hundred fifty-four of the  
2 private and special laws of nineteen hundred eleven, as  
3 amended by chapter forty-four of the private and special  
4 laws of nineteen hundred fifteen, is hereby further amended  
5 by striking out the word "twelve" in the second line of said  
6 section and inserting in the place thereof the word 'fifteen,'  
7 so that said section, as amended, shall read as follows:

‘Sect. 15. The judge of said court shall receive as compensation a salary of fifteen hundred dollars a year, and the recorder shall receive a salary of five hundred dollars a year, to be paid quarterly from the treasury of the county of Aroostook. A condition precedent to the payment of said salaries as aforesaid shall be the rendering by said judge and recorder of a correct statement to the county commissioners of said county of Aroostook, and the payment over by said judge and recorder to the county treasurer, of all fees both civil and criminal, collected by said court for the preceding quarter or fractional part thereof.’
