IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Clerk Hire in the Office of Register of
Deeds, Southern District of Aroostook County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section forty-five of chapter one hundred and seventeen
2 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amend-
3 ed by striking out the words "twenty-four" in the third line
4 of paragraph three of said section, and inserting in place
5 thereof the words 'twenty-nine,' so that said paragraph of
6 said section, in so far as it relates to the amount allowed
7 for clerk hire in the office of register of deeds, Aroostook
8 county, southern district, as amended, shall read as follows:

'In Aroostook county, for clerks in the office of register
2 of deeds of the southern district, twenty-nine hundred
3 dollars.'
