STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, Providing for the Construction of an International Bridge Over St. John River Between the Town of Fort Kent, Aroostook County, Maine, and the Parish of St. Francis, Madawaska County, New Brunswick.

Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated such
2 moneys as may be necessary to pay one-half the cost of the
3 construction of an international highway bridge over the
4 St. John river between the town of Fort Kent, Aroostook
5 county, Maine, and the village of Clair in the parish of
6 St. Francis, Madawaska county, New Brunswick, and the
7 total cost of the construction of the approach highway con-
8 necting the bridge with an existing highway in the town of
9 Fort Kent. Provided, that the town of Fort Kent shall

10 render available without cost to the state all right of way
 11 areas on the Maine shore required for the construction of
 12 the bridge and its approach. Provided further, that the
 13 expenditure of moneys appropriated by this resolve shall
 14 not be made until the Dominion of Canada or the Province
 15 of New Brunswick shall provide a sum of money adequate
 16 to pay one-half the cost of the bridge and the total cost of
 17 the New Brunswick approach. Provided further, that the
 18 expenditure of this appropriation and the location, planning
 19 and construction of the bridge in so far as the state of Maine
 20 shall be concerned shall be under the direction and super-
 21 vision of the state highway commission. The state of
 22 Maine's share of this bridge shall not exceed one hundred
 23 and fifty thousand dollars.
