STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Regulate Camping Within the Limits of Game Preserves or Sanctuaries.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section I. It shall be unlawful for any hunter or hunters

- 2 having firearms in possession to camp at any time within
- 3 the limits of any game preserve or sanctuary, established
- 4 either by legislative enactment, or by rules and regulations
- 5 of the department of inland fisheries and game promulgated
- 6 in accordance with law.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any provision of this act shall

- 2 be subject to a penalty of not less than fifty dollars, nor
- 3 more than one hundred dollars, and costs, for each offense,
- 4 or imprisonment for sixty days, or both said fine and im-
- 5 prisonment.
