STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Render Unlawful All Disturbances to the Reception of Radio Waves Used for Radiotelephony.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to use within the state of
2 Maine any radio receiving set which radiates radio waves,
3 between two hundred and five hundred and fifty meters
4 wave length, thereby causing interference with the reception
5 of any other radio receiving set unless said radiating set
6 shall be rebuilt or re-designed to prevent said radiation.

Sect. 2. Whoever knowingly, maliciously or wantonly by
2 any means unreasonably disturbs the reception of radio

3 waves used for radiotelephony, between two hundred and
4 five hundred and fifty meters wave length, shall be punished
5 by a fine of not less than ten dollars and not more than
6 fifty dollars to be recovered by complaint in any municipal
7 or police court or before any trial justice.
