STATE OF MAINE

**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN**

AN ACT Conferring Authority upon Municipal Officers to
Enforce the Laws and the Rules and Regulations Relating
to Trucks upon the Highway.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The municipal officers of each city, town and plantation,
2 shall, within their respective municipalities, have the same
3 power as the chief and members of the state highway police
4 in the enforcement of the provisions of section twenty of
5 chapter two hundred eleven of the public laws of nineteen
6 hundred twenty-one and of all rules and regulations pro-
7 mulgated by the state highway commission, the county com-
8 missioners and the municipal officers of towns pertaining

9 thereto, and in arresting all violators thereof and in prose-
10 cuting all offenders against the same; such municipal officers
11 shall, in such cases, serve without compensation.
